Behaviour expectations September 2020

Travel to/from school

- Students are expected to follow social distancing when walking to/from school. Students will arrive at their specified time and identified entrance.
- Students using buses to travel to and from school must follow guidance and wear face masks and maintain social distancing where possible. Students must fill the bus from the back and then allow those sitting closest to the driver to exit first to maintain social distancing.
- When entering or leaving the school building students will be encouraged to wash their hands or apply hand sanitiser.
- Students can wear face masks if they want to but must avoid touching their faces, noses, etc.
- Do not wait around for friends or congregate outside school in the morning or in school at the end of the day. Speak to a member of staff if your parent or carer who normally collects you is not on time.

Classroom expectations

- Students will be expected to use the hand sanitiser in each classroom when they enter or leave. This will be under the instructions of the member of staff.
- Students will sit in the seating plan as directed by the teacher. This is non-negotiable and for the students' safety. Do not move tables or seats
- Students and Staff follow the 'Catch it, Bin it, Kill it', guidance and avoid touching their faces, noses etc. practice followed whilst at school. They must use the lidded bins which are available in every classroom.
- Students must cough and sneeze into their elbow and away from the direction of other pupils and staff.
- Students should avoid physical contact with others at all times. This means maintaining a safe distance from others between and during lessons, following signage around school and directions from staff.
- Students should have all of their own equipment to learn and not share this with others.

Brunch and Lunchtime expectations
